

**MIRPLEES K AND K MAJOR ENGINE POWERPOINT PRESENTATION
ANSON ENGINE MUSEUM, POYNTON CHESHIRE
THURSDAY 30th SEPTEMBER 2010**

A PowerPoint presentation will be made by Trevor Owen on the Mirrlees K and K Major engine ranges based on the IDGTE Heritage Paper which was published in the Power Engineer in September 2009 (and which is available for download from the Members' area at www.idgte.org). Whilst the presentation will be based on the above mentioned paper there will be substantial new material covering the history of the company and its products leading up to the K design.

The Anson Engine Museum will have a display of Mirrlees parts, models, photographs, and publications which Members and their guests can inspect before and/or after the presentation. In addition access will be available to all the current museum displays including a recently acquired photograph album showing the Mirrlees factory and various engine installations which will be on display.
